80118A	Celadon	Pale opalescent grey-green; subtle in color. Martha Stewart would like this color very much.	41	\$31.80
001138	Dark Amber	Darker version of Medium Amber (001137). Transparent.	3	\$24.15
70406A	Deep Aubergine	Deepest brown-purple opalescent, like the skin of a dark eggplant.	15	\$31.80
71217A	Deep Gray	Opalescent gray. Neutral, fashionable and noticeably darker than standard 000136, Deco Gray. Color lightens with flamework.	46	\$25.40
000224	Deep Red	This style deepens with heatwork, resulting in a dark crimson. Opalescent. See the sheet glass version on page 9 of Bullseye Catalog 5.	129	\$31.80
001207	<b>NEW</b> Fern Green	Transparent green with grey to brown undertones. Nice shade-garden foliage hue with medium to dark color saturation.	200	\$24.15
50209A	Fudgesicle	Dark translucent brown.	74	\$31.80
61016A	Hematite Lustre	Reduce this transparent lustre rod to bring out a metallic effect. While annealing, it continues to develop into a reflective black metallic.	73	\$70.80
80321A	<b>NEW</b> Lemon-Lime Sparkle	A blend of Yellow (001120, a striking glass) and Light Aventurine Green (001412). Similar to Seaweed Aventurine (001812), but with a yellow hue. Use this glass over a light opalescent style (like 000013, Opaque White) to show off its lemony flavor. Transparent. Expect variation.	230	\$31.80
50215A	Light Pink Sapphirine	Lighter shade of pink than Light Pink Striker (001215), with a brownish surface color. Transparent.	41	\$37.15
70817A	Light Sunset Coral	Lighter, more transparent version of Sunset Coral (001305). Striker.	18	\$37.15
001416	Light Turquoise Blue	Transparent, less saturated version of Turquoise Blue (001116).	138	\$24.15
000138	Marzipan Striker	Pale almond opalescent. A slightly translucent, nonreactive neutral.	78	\$31.80
80211A	Mossy Oak	Muted brown-green opalescent with subtle brown streaks.	123	\$31.80
41215A	Orange Lollipop	Transparent orange striker with an opalescent orange streak. Saturated with color, once completely struck.	10	\$31.80
60328A	Pale Plum	Less saturated version of Light Plum (001405). Transparent.	64	\$31.80
80527A	Pebble	Medium grey-brown opalescent, some rods with a subtle blending of white (resulting in a lighter, slightly streaked color). A shade lighter than previously released Mushroom (80214A). Expect variation.	43	\$31.80
61230A	Periwinkle	Pastel blue violet, opalescent.	77	\$31.80
000225	Pimento Red	This tasty shade of opalescent orange is a shade darker than our standard Orange (000125). See the sheet glass version on page 8 of Bullseye Catalog 4, but note that the struck rod color is a little lighter.	182	\$25.40

000009	Reactive Cloud	Opalescent white with reactive potential. Interface reactions may develop when combined with silver and/or copper, whether in glass form or with the metals more directly, such as with leaf or foil. Reactions range from subtle to dramatic, generally in an earthy, rustic color palette. Experiment and document.	76	\$31.80
001009	Reactive Ice Clear	Colorless clear with reactive potential. Interface reactions may develop when combined with silver and/or copper, whether in glass form or with the metals more directly, such as with leaf or foil. Reactions range from subtle to dramatic, generally in an earthy, rustic color palette. Transparent. Experiment and document.	67	\$31.80
80624A	Robins Egg II	Natural, true, robin's-egg blue. Muted, turquoise opalescent.	125	\$31.80
80213A	Soft Teal	Opalescent blue-green. Similar to Mineral Green (000117), with more blue. "Soft" describes color as opposed to viscosity.	29	\$31.80
80523A	Spicy Dijon	Opalescent, mustard yellow of the spicy-brown variety. A fashionable cousin to Golden Green (000227). Expect slight variation in the struck color.	66	\$31.80
70115A	Sterling Gray	This pastel opalescent gray is a lighter version of Deco Gray (000136).	23	\$31.80
80507A	Translucent Sky Blue	Strikes to cloudy, translucent blue from transparent blue. After forming, if it has not struck already: cool, gently reheat and then cool again to strike. Similar in color to Light Sky Blue (001414). Similar in opacity and working properties to Translucent White (000243), though somewhat easier to strike. Opalescent.	104	\$31.80
70917A	Vintage Rose II	Muted pink opalescent with subtle hints of yellow. Expect slight variation.	14	\$37.15
